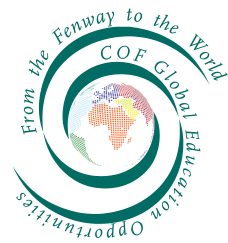


## Guide for COF Students with Disabilities or Other Challenges to Prepare for a Travel Program

Below are some questions we suggest you look over and discuss with the Disability Support Service Provider at your college.

- Given the program you will be participating in, what kind of accommodations and support will you need?
- What types of activities will you be participating in while abroad? Examples include classroom learning, volunteering, field trips, service learning, work, independent research, internship.
- Have you contacted the Office of Disability Support Services, or its equivalent, at the abroad institution to inquire about the accommodation process?
- Have you contacted your local study abroad coordinator?
- Can the travel program provide the accommodations you are requesting? If so, what documentation is required?
- What additional support services (psychiatric, medical, physical, health, learning, etc.) will you need regarding your disability? Your consideration should include, medication, counseling and additional equipment.
- Have you checked with your travel program coordinator, airline and/or the host country embassy to see whether you will be able to bring with you enough medication to last for your entire trip and whether the country abroad and /or their immigration customs policies allow you to carry that amount of medication?
- Have you identified a back-up plan for your needs?
- Do you have any other concerns?

**Please note:** The insurance company **HTH Worldwide Assist** has a website that provides extensive information for their customers, including different countries' medication policies and translations, local doctors/clinics, and other resources that may be helpful to you before departure and while traveling. Pre-existing conditions are covered by HTH. All students on COF school travel courses should be enrolled in HTH by their study abroad advisor before departure; students going on semester abroad programs may choose to purchase HTH coverage.
